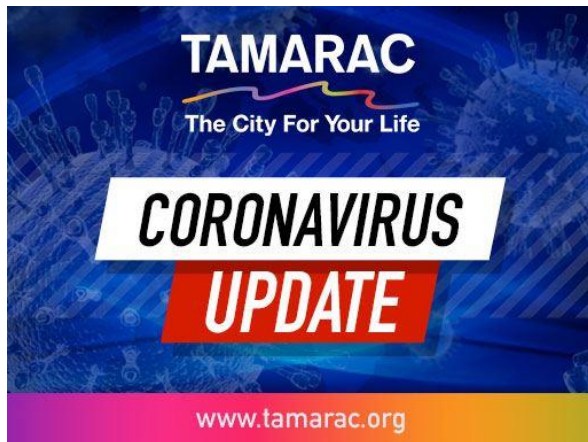

## Broward County Emergency Rental Assistance

Qualified Broward County residents negatively impacted by COVID-19 can now apply for Emergency Rental Assistance. To be eligible, residents must be able to show a documented loss or reduction in income due to the pandemic, and the inability to pay rent or utility bills.
